

# Study & Play

Explore & More is excited to offer a new program for the 2020-2021 school year – **Study & Play!** Study & Play is an educator led program designed to assist your child in their academic learning provided by your school district. Our goal is to help support children's education needs by delivering play experiences, safe social interactions and nurturing children's overall health and well-being. With half of the day dedicated to homework help and the other half enriching play based learning activities, participants are guaranteed to have so much fun they won't even realize they are learning!

Please read the following guidelines to ensure you and your child are prepared for the program.

## Pricing

The pricing information below is for a one day program.

- Half Day Study & Play (8:30am – 12:00pm)
  - ▶ \$35 for non-members
  - ▶ \$30 for members
- Full Day Study & play (8:30am – 4:00pm)
  - ▶ \$50 for non-members
  - ▶ \$45 for members
- Late pick up is available for an additional fee. Pick up between 4:01pm – 4:30pm is \$10 per child and 4:31pm – 5:00pm \$20 per child. The late pick up fee must be paid prior to your child being allowed to participate in the next scheduled session.



## The Basics

- This is a study hall program. This program is not designed to replace any academic instruction provided by your school district.
  - Students will sign up for one of two groups; 1st/2nd grade or 3rd/4th grade. There are a maximum of 12 participants per group.
  - This program is available for either a half day (8:30am – 12:00pm) or full day (8:30am – 4:00pm). Whether you select full or half day, 50% of the program time will be dedicated to providing your child time and assistance in completing their homework assigned by the school district.
- Wi-Fi will be available should your child need to access a virtual classroom or log in for virtual instruction from the school district. Access to virtual instruction must occur between the hours of 9:00am – 11:30am for the half day program and 9:00am – 2:30pm for the full day program. Headphones are required to be used during virtual instruction.

## What to Bring

***Please label all items with your child's first and last name prior to drop off.***

- Make sure your child comes prepared for the day and remembers to bring a backpack with all materials needed to successfully complete assignments. Materials could include but are not limited to: Chromebooks (or other assigned electronics), worksheets, notebooks, folders, headphones etc.
- Your child is required to come to the program with their own mask.
- Don't forget your lunch, snacks and a filled water bottle for your child each day.

## Safe Participation Standards

Explore & More requires staff and students to meet health screening criteria in order to ensure a safe experience. Please review the requirements below to ensure that your child is eligible to participate in Explore & More's programs before registering and prior to attending.

## Eligible to Participate

- No symptoms of COVID-19.
- No travel to/from high-risk areas as defined by the CDC.
- No travel by airplane, train, or cruise ship within the past 14 days.
- No prolonged contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19.
- All participants must be potty-trained. No pull-ups.

## Ineligible to Participate

- Diagnosed with COVID-19.
- Showing symptoms of COVID-19.
- Living in a household with someone diagnosed with, showing symptoms of, or confirmed exposure to COVID-19.
- Traveled to/from high-risk areas as defined by the CDC.
- Traveled by airplane, train, or cruise ship within the past 14 days.

## Health & Safety Measures

*All Explore & More Study & Play families must comply with the following protocols to create a safe environment. These protocols may change as local, state and CDC guidelines are revised.*

- There will be no intermingling between other Study & Play groups or the general public at the Museum.
- Activity rooms and Museum exhibits will operate in a manner that supports social distancing. Students will learn how to social distance in all program spaces.
- Caregivers will be asked to answer health screen questions about each student during drop off. Temperature checks are required as part of the drop off procedure. If your child has a fever they will not be allowed to participate.
- Masks must be worn at all times, except while eating. Explore & More staff is also required to wear masks at all times.
- Explore & More is not liable for any lost or damaged equipment. All personal items will be locked in a secured room during Museum exploration time.
- Legal guardians are required to fill out an Emergency Contact form prior to dropping off your child.
