MATERIALS

- Canvas
- Masking/painter's tape
- Paint
- Paintbrush
- Water cup and paper towel for painting

The objective of this lesson is for a child of any age to create an artistic masterpiece. This art project will allow for children to be as messy or as precise as they would like, as the tape will create a design of its own. This project is a great way to showcase your child's art as it will always lead to success!

DIRECTIONS



STEP 1 Take your tape and tape it down in any design style you would like. Make sure you put long enough pieces of tape so that you can remove them afterwards.

STEP 2 Paint! Take some time and paint everywhere, its okay to get paint on the tape.

STEP 3 Allow the paint to dry.

STEP 4 Remove the tape carefully. This part is super satisfying!

STEP 5 Admire your work of art. And display proudly!

NOTE: The tape can be placed in a variety of ways, you can try writing a name or word with the tape. Or even designing an animal or creature with your tape. This style of art can be done in a multitude of mediums, such as sidewalk chalk, computer paper, or even a large poster board.

MASTERPIECE: A work of outstanding artistry, skill, or workmanship.
